INVITATION TO BID

Sealed bids will be received by Marlboro County, on Wednesday, September 29th until 2:00 p.m. for construction of Bennettsville Interconnect & Pump Station, at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud at Marlboro County Administrative Building in the Council Chambers which is located at 205 East Market Street, Bennettsville, SC 29512.

Bids must be submitted on the complete project and must be enclosed in a sealed envelope, addressed to Marlboro County. Outside of the envelope must be marked "Bid for Bennettsville Interconnect & Pump Station." Envelope must also bear, on the outside, the name of the bidder, bidder's address, and bidder's license number. All bids must be made on blank forms provided and included in the bound document or as provided by Addendum prior to bid. Mailed bids can be sent to Marlboro County; Attn: Cecil Kimrey; 205 East Market Street; Bennettsville, SC 29512. For mailed bids, the bid envelope shall be placed inside of the mailing envelope.

This project involves the installation of approximately 2440 lf of 6" water line along Highway 385 from Talon Plant Rd to Academy Road in Marlboro County. This line will interconnect the City of Bennettsville and Marlboro Water Company lines. A 6" Combination pressure reducing & pressure sustaining valve and meter will be placed near the interconnection. Also included in this project is a water booster pumping station which is to be located along Highway 385 at the intersection with Burnt Factory Road.

Bidders on this work will be required to comply with the President's Executive Order No. 11246 and Order No. 11375 which prohibit discrimination in employment regarding race, creed, color, sex or national origin.

Bidders must comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Davis-Bacon Act, the Anti-Kickback Act, the Contract Work Hours and Safety Standards Act, and 40 CFR 33.240.

This project will be constructed with funds provided by the SC Department of Commerce, Grants Administration, under the State's Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program.

Bidder must make positive efforts to use small and minority owned businesses.

Attention of bidders is particularly called to the requirements as to conditions of employment to be observed and minimum wage rates to be paid under the contract.

Each proposal shall be accompanied by a 5 % bid bond or cash deposit. Said deposit shall be retained by the Owner as liquidated damages in event of failure of the successful bidder to execute the contract within ten days after the award or to give satisfactory surety as required by law.
