As of this morning, there are no cases of COVID-19 ("coronavirus") in Marlboro County.

County Operations-

Marlboro County Government offices, including the Courthouse offices, are open. Protective measures have been taken to distance people where possible and additional cleaning procedures have been put in place. The public is encouraged to use online services or call by telephone where possible.

Public Safety departments (Sheriff, EMS, Detention Center and Fire) have equipment and procedures to deal with the current situation. The leaders of these functions have met and will continue to meet regularly to adjust procedures as recommended or mandated by health officials.
